THREAT/RISK LEVEL	BEHAVIOR	ACTION
HIGH	Direct and specific threats that impose an imminent danger to the safety of self or others	
	Active killer	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately.
	Attack/physical confrontation	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Student Conduct Incident Report Form .
	Direct statements of harm to self or others (verbal or written)	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Student Conduct Incident Report Form .
	Displays a weapon	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Student Conduct Incident Report Form .
	Suicidal ideation/attempt	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Behavior Intervention Team Report .
MODERATE	Significant or repeated disruption; signs of significant distress; no direct threat of harm present	
	Disruptive, verbally abusive behavior	Address the behavior directly with the student. If it continues, submit a Student Conduct Incident Report Form . Direct all questions to the Dean of Students Office at uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu .
	Statements of delusion or hallucinations	Submit a Behavior Intervention Team Form . Direct all questions to the Dean of Students Office at uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu .
	Harassment	Submit a Discrimination and Harassment Report . Direct all questions to the Title IX/Equity and Diversity Office at titleix@uhd.edu .

LOW	Concerning or low disruptive behavior; signs of distress; no direct threat of harm present	
	Academic Honesty Violation	Follow steps outlined in PS 03.A.19 section 4.1.1. Email copy of report to Dean of Students Office at uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu .
	Changes in academic performance/interaction	Meet with student to check-in and offer support. Refer student to the Academic Support Center (N925; 713-221-8669; asc@uhd.edu) & UHD Counseling Services (S204; 713-221-8121; counselingservices@uhd.edu)
	Changes in physical appearance or personal hygiene	Meet with student to check-in and offer support. Refer student to UHD Counseling Services (S204; 713-221-8121; counselingservices@uhd.edu)
	Disjointed speech or writing	Meet with student to check-in and offer support. Consult with the Office of the Dean of Students (uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu) if further intervention is needed.
	Unexplained crying or persistent sadness	Meet with student to check-in and offer support. Refer student to UHD Counseling Services (S204; 713-221-8121; counselingservices@uhd.edu)

Direct all other questions to the Title IX/Equity and Diversity Office at titleix@uhd.edu.</p>
	<p>Domestic or intimate partner violence</p>	<p>Submit a Sexual Misconduct Report. Per state, federal, and UH System policies, reports are required to be submitted within 24 hours of receiving the information implicating the SAM 01.D.08 Sexual Misconduct Policy. 	<p>Emergency financial need (Unforeseen circumstances)</p>	<p>Direct student to email the Dean of Students Office at uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu.</p>
	<p>Food insecurity</p>	<p>Direct student to email the UHD Food Market at uhdfoodsolarship@uhd.edu.</p>
	<p>Homelessness</p>	<p>Direct student to contact Dean of Students by calling 713-221-8100 or uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu.</p>
