

The University of Houston-Downtown is closely monitoring the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Regular updates, information on the virus (including symptoms and prevention), frequently asked questions, and other details are available on <a href="https://linear.com/UHD/s">UHD/s</a> Coronavirus website.

This website also contains updates to University of Houston System statements and policies related to the Coronavirus. These include the <u>COVID-19 Exposure Prevention Policy</u> requiring faculty, staff and students who recently visited any of the countries under a Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Level 2 or 3 Travel Warning to self-quarantine for a period of 14 days. Those individuals who have traveled to CDC Level 2 or 3 countries <u>must submit this form online</u>.

The University of Houston System also is currently prohibiting travel to countries designated with a Level 3 Travel Warning from the CDC. These include China, South Korea, Italy and Iran. These restrictions may impact University-sponsored travel for conferences, research or study abroad programs. UHD will evaluate travel opportunities on a case by case basis and make decisions that support the safety and welfare of faculty, staff and students.

As spring break approaches, UHD community members are reminded to review travel notices from the <u>University of Houston System, CDC</u> and <u>U.S. Department of State</u>, as well as the CDC's <u>tips for preventing sickness and injury while traveling</u>.
